At the Oratory

Eucharistic adoration is the act of worshipping God as He is present in the Blessed Sacrament. In adoration, one enters into the mystery of the same Christ who suffered, died, rose from the dead, and ascended into heaven. You can come at any time to visit our Eucharistic Lord who waits with arms wide open and with a heart burning for love of you.

At the Oratory, we are blessed to have perpetual adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, meaning that our Lord is exposed on the altar at all times of the day and night except during Mass. The Fathers of the Oratory invite you to participate in this work of devotion by committing to spending an hour of the week in adoration before the Blessed Sacrament as a scheduled adorer.
